Do not be deceived by their calls for more regulation and less freedom. These officers were killed by a man whose actions could not have been stopped by any laws, existing or waiting to be enacted. Tragedy occurs regardless of law. It is up to us, the law-abiding firearms owners, to continue the fight for freedom in the memory of these fine men. God bless them and their families.

## CMP The Civilian Marksmanship Program

a rich heritage in our country. This type of sport shooting was originally sponsored by the military in order to provide citizens with an opportunity to learn how to handle a battle rifle and to provide a pool of trained marksmen to supplement national defense.

Our club puts on a CMP Shoot, on the outdoor rifle range, from 9-11AM, the first Sunday of every month. These shoots are open to the public. Any military rifle with iron sights can be used. This includes AR's, Garands, AK's, SKS's, 1903's, K98's and any other military arm. The club provides M1 Garands, M1 Carbines, and AR-15's which can be rented on a first-come first-serve basis. Ammunition is also for sale at a lower price than can be found in stores.

NRA Certified Range Safety Officers are on site. Fees are \$15 for members (\$5.00 with own ammo and weapon) and \$20 for guests (\$10.00 with own ammo and weapon). Junior members may shoot our M1 carbines for FREE.

\*\*\* Juniors must be accompanied by parent/guardian and should have (but not required) completed the Hunter Trapper Education classes.\*\*\*
