MEMBER SPOTLIGHT.....

Mr. Ted Bernard 02/09/05

I just spent the good part of this evening with a fellow PMSC member. We were paying our respect to Milt Lersch and his family. There we were two "Red Coats" (club jackets) in the midst of greiving relatives and friends of our deceased buddy Milt. We were wearing Milt's colors as he so often did but also our own as we represented a club we'd spent many years a part of. I learned a little more about my partner this evening and so will share some of it with you.

Ted Bernard is a gentleman that has been active at PMSC several years primarily as a trap shooter and for a while our Trap Commander. Ted is a complex fellow. 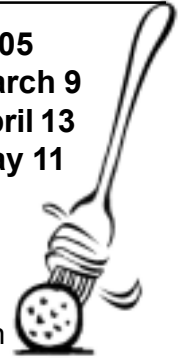
