Twenty Points of Gun Safety

1. Treat every gun as if it were loaded.
2. Keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
3. Carry guns safely.
4. Keep your gun's safely on until ready to shoot.
5. Unload guns when not in use.
6. Keep actions open when not in use.
7. Always use a case when transporting a gun to and from shooting areas.
8. Be sure the gun barrel is free of obstructions.
9. Carry only the correct size ammunition for the gun you are carrying.
10. Be sure of your target before you pull the trigger.
11. Know the identifying features of the game you hunt.
12. Never point a gun at anything you do not intend to shoot.
13. Never play games or horse around with guns.
14. Never climb or jump with a loaded gun.
15. Never pull a gun toward you by the muzzle.
16. Never fire a bullet at water or other flat, hard surfaces.
17. Make sure your backstop is safe and will stop your shot.
18. Keep guns and ammunition out of the reach of children or unauthorized adults.
19. Keep guns and ammunition stored separately in locked compartments.
20. Avoid alcohol and drugs before and during shooting.

AUGUST, PMSC will open a brand new Shotgun Sport venue ñ a 5-Stand range featuring 7 automatic traps with 3 levels of challenge.

***** 5-Stand-the Sport- ***** From the National Sporting Clays Association Description

NSCA 5-Stand is a shotgun shooting game using sporting clays, which can be designed to fit into an exiting skeet and/or trap field or any shooting range with a limited amount of space. † This game offers shooters of all abilities some of the most exciting target combinations available in the world today.

The NSCA 5-Stand layouts utilize 6 or 8 automatic traps to simulate game birds such as teal, dove, quail, pheasant and even a bolting rabbit. † Specialty targets such as battues and midis add even more interest for the shooter. † Targets can be released in a predetermined set sequence that is clearly marked on each stand or in a sequence unknown to the shooter, where the element of surprise recreates conditions in the field while hunting.

Exciting events consist of 25/50/75 or even 100 targets, shot from 5 stands, 5 shots from each stand, with each shooter simply rotating from station to station. † Depending on the skill level selected, a squad of five can shoot a round of 25 clays each in about 20 minutes.

There are endless combinations of target flights. † Each time you shoot an NSCA 5-Stand event, the trap location, target elevation, target speed and target direction will be different. † That is the exciting and fun challenge of shooting NSCA 5-Stand.

..... 5-Stand Grand Opening at PMSCóNext Month

We're going to have a weekend **Grand Opening** of the 5-Stand Course. Tentative plans call for FREE HOT DOGS AND HAMBURGERS for all shooters, and, a special Introductory Price of only \$3.00 a round (25 birds) for members and \$4.00 a round for non-members ó for that weekend only. Normal range prices will be \$4.00 a round for Club Members, and \$5.00 a round for Non-Members.

In addition to Free Food and Reduced Prices, the Grand Opening Weekend will feature optional Lewis Class competitions and shooting prizes. If there is interest, we'll set up special squads for kids and ladies to learn the game.

EVERYONE can enjoy 5-Stand!

Here's Why: The degree of difficulty/challenge on a 5-Stand course is determined by the *Shooting Menu* (or program). The program tells you what birds are launched and in what order. At PMSC we'll have 3 menus/programs for 5-Stand operating at all times. The shooter chooses which 25 bird menu/program they will shoot. There are 5 birds shot at each of the 5 stations. Each of the 7 traps is marked with a large number, 1 through 7.

Shown below is an example of how the shooting program/menu changes the degree of challenge at each station. Assume this is Station # 1.

Bronze Menu (Low Difficulty): Single # 5 (Trap # 5), Single # 2, Single # 6, Report Pair #1 and # 4.

Silver Menu (Moderate Challenge): Single # 7, Report Pair # 3 and # 7, True Pair # 1 and # 4

Gold Menu (High Challenge): Single # 6, True Pair # 1 and # 7, True Pair # 2 and # 3

Other Stuff About 5-Stand: Two shots are allowed for all singles. 5-Stand is shot much like Trap. The shooter at Station # 1 shoots their first single ó followed by the shooters at Stations # 2 through # 5. The next two pairs are shot the same way. Then shooters rotate like Trap ó shooter # 1 goes to Station # 2, etc., Shooter # 5 goes to Station # 1.

Proposed 5-Stand Summer Schedule @ PMSC:

Fridays: 4-5PM till 9 PM Saturdays: 9AM to 7PM (or until?)

Sundays: 9AM till 6 PM (or until)

NOTE: PMSC is going to need volunteers to meet this ambitious operating schedule!

5-Stand Leagues: No reason why not if the Members would like one.

PMSC WEEKEND SHOTGUN IRON MAN SHOOT: How about a 150 bird contest to determine the Best Shotgunner at PMSC? This weekend shoot would consist of 2 rounds of Trap, 2 Rounds of Skeet, 2 rounds of 5-Stand. If that is not challenging enough we could add a round of 5-Stand Doubles, and a round of Trap or Skeet Doubles to make it an even 200 bird Event.

Other Improvements

Lighting Upgrade: The single pole with two 1,000 watt lights has been replaced by two light poles. The two new light poles have been shortened by 6 feet and moved about 9 feet closer to the target breakpoints. We've more than **doubled the field illumination**. We now have 5,000 watts of light on two poles, where before we 2,000 watts of light on one poorly sited light pole.

Shotgun Instruction & Tune-Ups: Our 5-Stand course offers a wide variety of different shots and shot sequences i.e. Report Pairs, True Pairs, and Following Pairs. As both an NRA and NSCA certified Instructor, I know that this course offers a perfect environment for Shotgun Instruction ó either the beginner or the advanced shooter. If you're interested in a tune-up for Dove Season or you want to introduce the wife or kids to the shotgun sports ó contact me. See the information at the end of this article.

TRAP COMMITTEE

News From the Trap Field

*NEW OUTDOOR PISTOL RANGES-

The IPSC/training ranges have been constructed with minor grading. Additional wood chips are needed behind the backstops. Installation of 4x 8' target holders will be installed on the training range-already on site. We need to relocate the ifun house. Construction of a pavilion will commence in a month or so.
