Parents: Pitcairn Monroeville Sportsmen's Club Sponsoring monthly BB/air gun shoots

BB/air gun shoots *From a young shooter's first BB gun, to the precision air rifles and pistols men and women use in the Olympic games, air guns have spanned the generations. Air/BB gun shooting offers family fun, challenge, a chance to work on marksmanship, and enjoyment that can last a lifetime.* Our program will give children ages six to twelve years old the knowledge, and then the confidence, to first and foremost safely handle a rifle (air/BB gun).

They will learn:

- Rules of safe gun handling
- Proper range commands
- How to conduct ones self on a range with multiple shooters.
- Three position shooting: standing, kneeling and bench rest.
- Proper sight alignment.
- Trigger control

First they will take an hour-long firearms safety class. After that, it's plinking time: pop cans, clays, and all manner of reactive (knock down/shatter) targets. We also have \$ filled balloons. Here they will put into practice all that they have just learned.

We have six CO2 "Black Diamond" BB guns or they may use their own rifle and they can bring their friends. With the instruction they receive and the hands on use of our rifles your child will develop

confidence and take responsibility for safety in the uses of a firearm!

MEMBER SPOTLIGHT.....

Mr. Roland Fero

There are many of you I could write about that are older, been members longer, better looking and possibly smarter, but this guy is a character worth writing about as he gives me so much material. I got to know him five or six years ago as we were stocking the Turtle Creek. I looked around the stream as we were waiting for buckets of trout being brought to us by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission and folks helping. We had Dave McMaster's float boxes and would wade down the Turtle Creek and distribute the fish all the way to Trafford. As I looked at the waders around me all were older folks of the post retirement, geriatric set. One of the new waders was this young guy with all black hair. Most of us that had any hair, well, its color was gray or 'silver' like some of the more vane among us called it. As we had a long haul ahead of us I think I said or asked this 'youngster' to help me.

The guy turned out to be Roland Fero. I find out later he has more medical problems than me, but there he was and is still a big help around the club. I found him one evening with two or three of his daughters about a quarter mile down the creek teaching the girls how to fish for trout. He deserves a lot of credit getting these 'under ten somethings' on the stream and teaching them the fun of fishing. Its not always an easy matter getting our children involved and stream fishing is demanding but here Roland was doing his best. He continues to help with the stocking and has even modified his red truck to make it fit better along the tight spots down stream. Roland is an avid outdoors man.

Roland has several nice trophies, among them is a fox and ptarmigan. He got them, I believe, while hunting caribou a few years back. He brought them to a meeting not long ago and it is very unique as most of us don't see to many ptarmigan. Roland is a hard hunter spending a lot of time at his sport. He is also active at PMSC as a member of the board, helps with the BB Gun Prog ram, shoots in the CMP. and probably has as much 'rump-time' on the backhoe as our Henry. Roland spent many hours working on the IPSC range. He recently headed our budget committee, and is always looking or thinking about ways to improve our club. Maybe we'll see a windmill or tank on our grounds yet! Roland is a character of the first order and not too concerned about how he looks. You can usually recognize him by his well worn blaze orange overalls and a beard that is starting to show a little 'silver'. Roland is not vane, so I suppose I should say salt and pepper.
