Motions

1. 3. So move that any individual/s collecting money on behalf of/for PMSC not directly under the control of the Treasurer be reported to the Treasurer on a monthly basis.

4. So move that any Club member who violates the above to clarify section 3.94 of the By-Laws be placed under review in accordance with the By-Laws section 4.7.
