NRA INSTRUCTOR TRAINING PROGRAM

This programs goal is to develop instructors to teach **NRA Basic Firearm Training Courses** according to lesson plans and training standards of the **National Rifle Association**. The **NRA** Instructor Training Course is designed to teach you **how to teach** Shooting Skills to others using **NRA** lesson plans and training methods. Possession of basic firearm safety and /or shooting skills is a prerequisite for certification as an **NRA** Instructor, you will be asked to demonstrate your firearm background through participation in pre-course assessment exercises.

A complete **NRA** Training Course consists of two parts. The first is Basic Instructor Training, which consists of 6 hours of instruction. The second part is discipline specific instructor training which consists of 10 ñ 14 hours of instruction **per discipline except for Home Firearm Safety**.

Classes begin at 8:00AM to 5:00PM with appropriate breaks. All pertinent materials are furnished, including all course materials, instructor cap and ring binder notebook for each student. It is suggested you bring a pencil and hi-liter to class. Our fees are \$60.00 per student for Instructor Training, \$60.00 per student for each Discipline and \$75.00 for Range Safety Officer training. All disciplines and Personal Protection, cost would be \$375.00. Add \$60.00 for Home Firearm Safety. There is a 50% **non-refundable deposit** for class reservation, the balance to be paid on the first day of class. Checks are to be made and sent to either Training Counselor by **Sept 25, 2005**. We are offering all disciplines.

Tentative schedule: **Oct 15**, Instructor Training, **16** Pistol start Personal Protection, **22** complete Personal Protection, **23** Rifle/Shotgun **29** complete Shotgun **Nov.5** start & finish Range Safety Officer. **Nov.6** Home Fire Arm Safety.
